

MARIE BOSTWICK FRIENDSHIP QUILT **PROJECT** January 2021 Block Set **Kitty Gonzalez**

- In anticipation of our meeting with author, Marie Bostwick, in April, you may wish to join in a friendship quilt project as described in her second book, A Thread of Truth. In this novel, the quilters create quilts using the same nine blocks but using colors of their choice. The completed quilts demonstrate that these quilters, while sharing the common love of quilting, each have different talents and creative ideas.
- For our project, Kitty Gonzales and Mary Bruno have chosen eight blocks for us to make. The difference in our project will be for you to make the ninth block, which will be in the center, in your own creative way. You can use a pieced block, or applique or paper piecing, or any other idea you have, to give your quilt originality. We will share our quilts at a meeting near the end of March, so you have almost three whole months to work on it. If it's not quilted yet, that will be ok. When you are finished with your quilt you may keep it or donate it. That will be up to you.





Indian Star Direction Sheet






